ORDER

Following the extension of the discovery period in this case (Doc. 29), Plaintiff filed a document labeled “Request for Discovery, Inspection, and Notice of Intent to Use Evidence.” (Doc. 31). While the document was docketed as a motion, it appears to be Plaintiff’s attempt to seek discovery from Defendants and requests no discernible relief from the Court at this time. Plaintiff is again advised that discovery materials are not to be filed with the Court. *See* (Doc. 8, p. 11-12). Plaintiff must direct any discovery requests to Defendants through their counsel.¹ Accordingly, the Clerk’s office is **DIRECTED** to **TERMINATE** the motion (Doc. 31) as filed.
