ORDER

Defendant was indicted on May 9, 2023, ECF. 12, and arraigned on May 16, 2023, ECF 21. A pretrial conference is currently scheduled for June 14, 2023. Defendant requests a continuance and the government does not oppose. Specifically, Defendant will need time to discuss plea agreement terms with the Government.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above-referenced matter be continued to next term of Court set for January 2024 and that the Speedy Trial deadline for the trial in this matter imposed by 18 U.S.C. § 3161(c)(1) be extended to that time. The Court finds that the ends of justice served by granting of this continuance outweigh the best interests of the public and the Defendant in a speedy trial because a failure to grant such continuance could result in a miscarriage of justice and would deny counsel for the Defendant and Government the reasonable time necessary for effective preparation. 18 U.S.C. §§ 3161(h)(7)(A)-(B). The delay occasioned by this continuance shall not be considered in calculating the speedy trial deadline under the Speedy Trial Act.
