ORDER

The defendant, by and through his counsel, has moved the Court to continue this case to the next trial term. Doc. 25. The defendant was indicted on March 14, 2023, and had his arraignment in this Court on March 30, 2023. Docs. 1; 10. Two prior continuances have been granted. Docs. 18; 23. The defendant, by and through his counsel, now moves the Court to continue this case to the next trial term to provide additional time to finish discussion and/or negotiations for a potential plea. Doc. 25 at 1. The government does not oppose the motion. *Id.*

Pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(7)(A), the Court finds the ends of justice served by granting this continuance outweigh the best interests of the public and the defendant to a speedy trial. Accordingly, the motion (Doc. 25) is **GRANTED**. The case is continued from the September term until the Court's trial term presently scheduled for **November 13, 2023**. The corresponding delay shall be deemed excludable pursuant to the provisions of the Speedy Trial Act, 18 U.S.C. §§ 3161 *et seq.*
