ORDER DISMISSING CASE

On June 2, 2026, the Court granted *pro se* Plaintiff Elizabeth Duffy’s Motion to Proceed *In Forma Pauperis* (“IFP”).¹ But after conducting a preliminary screening under 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2) and determining she failed to state a claim, the Court ordered her to file a recast complaint within 21 days of the Order’s date.² On June 16, 2026, the Order mailed to Plaintiff was returned as undeliverable because Plaintiff’s address number did not exist.³ Plaintiff has failed to comply with the Court’s Order to file a recast complaint because she has not filed a recast complaint within 21 days of the Order’s date. Moreover, Plaintiff has failed to prosecute this action because she failed to provide a valid mailing

address to the Court. Accordingly, the Court **DISMISSES** this case **WITHOUT PREJUDICE** for failure to prosecute under Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(b).
