**REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION
CONCERNING PLEA OF GUILTY¹**

The Defendant, Charles Carter, by consent, has appeared before the undersigned United States Magistrate Judge and has entered a plea of guilty to Counts One, Two and Three of the First Superseding Indictment. After cautioning and examining the Defendant under oath concerning each of the subjects mentioned in Rule 11, I have determined that the guilty plea was knowing and voluntary, and that the plea to the offenses charged is supported by an independent basis in fact establishing each of the essential elements of the offenses.

It is, therefore, **RECOMMENDED** that the plea of guilty be accepted and that the Defendant be adjudged guilty and have sentence imposed accordingly.
