**ORDER ADOPTING REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION**

Having reviewed Magistrate Judge Kennard P. Foster's Report and Recommendation that Alisha Decker's supervised release be modified, pursuant to Title 18 U.S.C. §3401(i), Rule 32.1(a)(1) *Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure* and Title 18 U.S.C. §3583, the Court now approves and adopts the Report and Recommendation as the entry of the Court, and orders a sentence imposed of imprisonment of up to 180 days in the custody of the Attorney General. It is recommended that defendant be designated to a community corrections center, namely, Volunteers of America. Upon Ms. Decker's release from confinement, she will return to her term of supervised release under the terms presently imposed.
