ORDER

AND NOW, this 14th day of July, 2017, upon consideration of the court’s order (Doc. 82) granting the motion (Doc. 67) by defendant Kevin Coles (“Coles”) to suppress any statements made during a post-arrest interview with law enforcement on July 7, 2016, based upon the government’s assertion that “the United States will not use at trial . . . any statements given by [Coles] from the July 7, 2016 post-arrest interview,” (Doc. 79 at 3), but it appearing from the government’s supplemental brief (Doc. 85) filed on today’s date that counsel continue to dispute admissibility of a separate post-arrest statement given by Coles on August 11, 2016, such that a hearing on Coles’ motion to suppress statements remains necessary, it is hereby ORDERED that:

1. Coles’ motion (Doc. 67) is reinstated to the extent he seeks to suppress any statements given during an August 11, 2016 post-arrest interview.
2. The court will hear evidence on the reinstated portion of the motion during the suppression hearing presently scheduled to commence at **10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, July 18, 2017**, in Courtroom No. 3, Eighth Floor, Federal Building, 228 Walnut Street, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania.
