ORDER

AND NOW, this 18th day of July, 2017, upon consideration of the court’s order (Doc. 82) granting the motion (Doc. 67) by defendant Kevin Coles (“Coles”) to suppress any statements made during a post-arrest interview with law enforcement on July 7, 2016, based upon the government’s assertion that “the United States will not use at trial . . . any statements given by [Coles] from the July 7, 2016 post-arrest interview,” (Doc. 79 at 3), and following a hearing on today’s date during which the government requested that the court amend its order to indicate that Coles’ motion (Doc. 67) was dismissed as moot rather than granted with concurrence, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the court’s order (Doc. 82) dated July 10, 2017 is **AMENDED** beginning at line 8 to read that Coles’ motion (Doc. 67) is **DENIED** as moot to the extent Coles seeks suppression of any statements given during the July 7, 2016 post-arrest interview.
