## ORDER

Before the Court in the above-styled cause of action is Plaintiff's Motion to Compel Production of Documents [\#66]. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendant University of Texas at San Antonio provide its supplemental responsive documents to RFP \#3 on or before October 6, 2023.
