

ADDITION TO RULE 37.

SUPREME COURT OF THE UNITED STATES.

OCTOBER TERM, 1923.

ORDER: It is ordered that the following be added as Section 5 to Rule 37 of this Court:

"5. Whenever application for the writ of certiorari to review a decision of any court, as provided in this rule, is granted, the clerk shall enter an order to that effect. The order shall also direct that the certified transcript of record on file here be deemed and treated as though sent up in reply to a formal writ, and that notice be given to the court or judges below and to counsel of record. No formal writ shall issue unless specially directed."
