

## AMENDMENT OF RULES.

### ORDER.

It is ordered that paragraph 1 of rule 36 of the rules of this Court be and the same hereby is amended by adding as the first sentence thereof the following:

"An appeal will be out of time unless, within the period fixed by statute, application for allowance is presented to the judge or justice who allows it. A prior timely application to another judge or justice does not extend the statutory period. See *Matton Steamboat Co. v. Murphy*, 319 U. S. 412."

It is ordered that Particulars I to this 68 of the rules of this Court as now and then made by authority of the following:—  
An Address will be sent to the two to three days, within the period of time, application for allowance is presented to the judge of the court, judge or magistrate who allows it. A trial judge shall be liable to damages or costs to the party whose suit is denied if the cause of action is founded on the allowance of the application for leave to sue, see *Malton Zinc Company Co. v. Attorney General for Ontario*, 310 U. S. 415.
