23, 1946, THROUGH JUNE 10, 1946.

No. 885. *HICKMAN, ADMINISTRATOR, v. TAYLOR ET AL., TRADING AS TAYLOR & ANDERSON TOWING & LIGHTERAGE CO., ET AL.* On petition for writ of certiorari to the Circuit Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit. May 27, 1946. The petition for rehearing is granted. The order of April 22 denying the petition for writ of certiorari, 327 U. S. 808, is vacated and the petition for writ of certiorari is granted. *Abraham E. Freedman* and *Charles Lakatos* for petitioner. *Lee Pressman* and *Frank Donner* filed a brief for the United Railroad Workers, as *amicus curiae*, in support of the petition.
