He took the oaths and his seat on the same day. See *post*, p. XIII. He was nominated by President Eisenhower on January 17, 1959; the nomination was confirmed by the Senate on May 5, 1959; he was given a new commission on May 7, 1959; and he again took the oaths on May 15, 1959.
