RAGAN v. COX, COMMANDANT.

ON PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI TO THE UNITED STATES COURT OF APPEALS FOR THE TENTH CIRCUIT.

Certiorari granted; order of Court of Appeals vacated insofar as it denies petitioner leave to proceed *in forma pauperis*; case remanded to that court for further proceedings.

PER CURIAM.

In accordance with the suggestion of the Solicitor General and upon consideration of the entire record, the motion for leave to proceed *in forma pauperis* and the petition for writ of certiorari are granted. The order of the Court of Appeals, insofar as it denies petitioner leave to proceed *in forma pauperis*, is vacated and the case is remanded to that court for further proceedings. *Simcox v.
