¹ THE HONORABLE THURGOOD MARSHALL, of New York, Solicitor General, was nominated by President Johnson on June 13, 1967, to be an Associate Justice of this Court; the nomination was confirmed by the Senate on August 30, 1967; he was commissioned on the same date; he took the Constitutional Oath on September 1, 1967, and the Judicial Oath and his seat on October 2, 1967. ³ The Honorable Erwin N. Griswold, of Massachusetts, was nominated by President Johnson to be Solicitor General on September 30, 1967; the nomination was confirmed by the Senate on October 12, 1967; he was commissioned on the same date, and took the oath on October 23, 1967. See also *post*, p. xi.
