Saxbe, of Ohio, was nominated to be Attorney General by President Nixon on December 10, 1973; the nomination was confirmed by the Senate on December 17, 1973; he was commissioned on January 4, 1974, and took the oath of office on the same date. He was presented to the Court on January 21, 1974 (see *post*, p. xi).

³ The Honorable Robert H. Bork, of Connecticut, was nominated by President Nixon to be Solicitor General on January 4, 1973; the nomination was confirmed by the Senate on February 1, 1973; he was commissioned on June 19, 1973, and took the oath on June 26, 1973. He was presented to the Court on October 1, 1973 (see *post*, p. vii).
