Unions and Awarded After Contracting

No. 82-122. *National Union of Marine and Shipbuilding Workers of America v. National Labor Relations Board*. 348 U.S. 422 (1955). Reversed below, 348 F. 2d 418. The judgment of the Court of Appeals is hereby granted as revised, and the case is remanded to the Court of Appeals with directions that the case be remanded to the National Labor Relations Board for further proceedings in accordance with the Court's findings, Jan. 20, 1955, 348 U.S. 422 (1955).

No. 82-1223. *In re U.S. Bank*. Order to show cause for writ of habeas corpus denied.
