No. 52-525. *UNITED STATES ET AL. v. ALABAMA*. Appeal from Sup. Ct. Alaska dismissed for want of substantial federal question. Justice Blackmun and Justice Stevens would have granted.

No. 51-1636. *FLORIDA v. BRADY ET AL.* Sup. Ct. Fla. (Hearings granted, 456 U. S. 982.) Motion of California Farm Bureau Federation et al. for leave to file a brief as amici curiae granted. writ of certiorari as to respondents Brady is dismissed, it appearing that the Circuit Court of Florida, Martin County, has accepted the State's sole proposal. Judgment as to the remaining respondents is vacated, and the case is remanded for further
