THE CHIEF JUSTICE said:

Before we rise for the summer, I would like to take the opportunity to note that our Reporter of Decisions, Frank D. Wagner, has announced his retirement, effective September 30th of this year. Few outside this Court are aware of the Reporter's important role. He is responsible for the preparation of the decisions of this Court for publication in the official United States Reports. Among many other things, the Reporter is responsible for preparing the syllabus and resolving issues of formatting style, punctuation, spelling, and citation form. Mr. Wagner has served as reporter for more than 23 years. He has overseen the publication of 82 volumes of the Supreme Court Reports, more than any previous reporter, going back 220 years.
