

GENERAL RULE.

AMENDMENT TO ORDER IN REFERENCE TO APPEALS FROM THE COURT OF CLAIMS.—RULE No. 1.

Strike out the whole of clause 2 of the rule, and insert in lieu thereof the following:

2. A finding by the Court of Claims of the facts in the case established by the evidence in the nature of a special verdict, but not the evidence establishing them; and a separate statement of the conclusions of law upon said acts, on which the court finds its judgment or decree. The finding of acts and conclusions of law to be certified to this court as a part of the record.
