CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate concurring), That it is the sense of the Congress that—

(1) the elections in Albania scheduled for June 29, 1997, should be free and open;

(2) all political parties of Albania should honor the results of such elections; and

(3) the Administration should work with other members of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization

- democratic Albania to NATO.
