## **CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

Recognizing and honoring the crew members of the U.S.S. Pittsburgh for their heroism in March 1945 rendering aid and assistance to the U.S.S. Franklin and its crew.

- Whereas on March 19, 1945, the U.S.S. Franklin, as part of Task Force 58, launched an attack against Japan;
- Whereas the Japanese launched a defensive air attack, striking the U.S.S. Franklin, killing 724 crew members and injuring 265 other crew members, and setting the U.S.S. Franklin ablaze;
- Whereas the U.S.S. Pittsburgh was dispatched to assist the U.S.S. Franklin and the crew of this vessel performed outstanding feats of seamanship which included, attaching a tow line to the flaming U.S.S. Franklin and rescu-

- ing 34 crew members of the U.S.S. Franklin from turbulent waters;
- Whereas the U.S.S. Pittsburgh and the U.S.S. Santa Fe defended against two additional Japanese air attacks while respectively towing and escorting the U.S.S. Franklin to safety;
- Whereas, as a result of their actions in March 1945, the crew of the U.S.S. Franklin was decorated, including awards of 2 Congressional Medals of Honor, 5 Gold Stars, 22 Silver Stars, and 250 Letters of Commendation and became the most decorated crew in United States Naval history;
- Whereas, as a result of their actions in March 1945, the crew of the U.S.S. Santa Fe received a Navy Unit Commendation; and
- Whereas the crew members of the U.S.S. Pittsburgh were never collectively honored or recognized for their heroism and bravery during the rescue of the U.S.S. Franklin and its crew: Now, therefore, be it

  - 2 nizes and honors the crew members of the U.S.S. Pitts-
  - 3 burgh for their heroism in March 1945 rendering aid and
  - 4 assistance to the U.S.S. Franklin and its crew.
