## **CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

- 1 Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate
- 2 concurring), That when the House adjourns on the legisla-
- 3 tive day of Wednesday, January 28, 1998, it stand ad-
- 4 journed until 12:30 p.m. on Tuesday, February 3, 1998;
- 5 that when the House adjourns on Thursday, February 5,

- 1 1998, it stand adjourned until 3:00 p.m. on Wednesday,
- 2 February 11, 1998; and that when the House adjourns
- 3 on Thursday, February 12, 1998, it stand adjourned until
- 4 12:30 p.m. on Tuesday, February 24, 1998, or until noon
- 5 on the second day after Members are notified to reassem-
- 6 ble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution,
- 7 whichever occurs first; and that when the Senate recesses
- 8 or adjourns at the close of business on Friday, February
- 9 13, 1998, pursuant to motion made by the Majority Lead-
- 10 er, or his designee, in accordance with this concurrent res-
- 11 olution, it stand recessed or adjourned until noon on Mon-
- 12 day, February 23, 1998, or such time on that day as may
- 13 be specified by the Majority Leader or his designee in the
- 14 motion to recess or adjourn, or until noon on the second
- 15 day after Members are notified to reassemble pursuant to
- 16 section 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs
- 17 first.
- 18 Sec. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
- 19 Leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with
- 20 the Minority Leader of the House and the Minority Lead-
- 21 er of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House

- 1 and the Senate, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in
- 2 their opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
