- 5 or until noon on the second day after Members are notified
- 6 to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent res-
- 7 olution, whichever occurs first; and that when the Senate
- 8 adjourns or recesses at the close of business on Thursday,
- 9 February 13, 1997, pursuant to a motion made by the
- 10 Majority Leader, or his designee, in accordance with this
- 11 concurrent resolution, it stand recessed or adjourned until
- 12 11:30 a.m. on Monday, February 24, 1997, or such time

- 1 on that day as may be specified by the Majority Leader
- 2 or his designee in the motion to recess or adjourn, or until
- 3 noon on the second day after Members are notified to reas-
- 4 semble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution,
- 5 whichever occurs first.
- 6 Sec. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
- 7 Leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with
- 8 the Minority Leader of the House and the Minority Lead-
- 9 er of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House
- 10 and the Senate, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in
- 11 their opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
