Mr. ARMEY submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was
considered and failed passage

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for an adjournment of the two Houses.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-
3 tive day of Thursday, May 22, 1997, or Friday, May 23,
4 1997, pursuant to a motion made by the majority leader
5 or his designee, it stand adjourned until 12:30 p.m. on
6 Tuesday, June 3, 1997, or until noon on the second day
7 after Members are notified to reassemble pursuant to sec-
8 tion 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first;
9 and that when the Senate recesses or adjourns at the close
10 of business on Thursday, May 22, 1997, Friday, May 23,
11 1997, or Saturday, May 24, 1997, pursuant to a motion
12 made by the majority leader, or his designee, in accord-

1 ance with this concurrent resolution, it stand recessed or
2 adjourned until noon on Monday, June 2, 1997, or such
3 time on that day as may be specified by the majority lead-
4 er or his designee in the motion to recess or adjourn, or
5 until noon on the second day after Members are notified
6 to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent res-
7 olution, whichever occurs first.

8 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the majority
9 leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with
10 the minority leader of the House and the minority leader
11 of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House and
12 the Senate, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in their
13 opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
