Condemning the military coup d'etat of May 26, 1997, in Sierra Leone.

- Whereas on May 26, 1997, a military coup d'etat of the Government of Sierra Leone took place;
- Whereas the Armed Forces Ruling Council (AFRC) has claimed responsibility for this coup d'etat; and
- Whereas there has been fighting, killing, looting, and a disruption of relief supplies in Sierra Leone since the coup d'etat: Now, therefore, be it
 - 1 Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate
 - 2 concurring), That the Congress—
 - 3 (1) condemns the military coup d'etat of May
 - 4 26, 1997, in Sierra Leone;

1	(2) urges an immediate end to all violence in
2	Sierra Leone; and
3	(3) calls on the Armed Forces Ruling Council
4	(AFRC) to return to power the elected leadership
5	and parliament of Sierra Leone.
