- Whereas the celebration of Leif Ericson's accomplishments is a tribute to Scandinavian Americans, who have loyally continued the tradition of exploration started by their courageous Norse ancestor; and

Whereas Leif Ericson is a proud symbol to the people of the United States of the unending quest for progress and the exploration of the unknown: Now, therefore, be it
