## JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States to limit the terms of office for Representatives and Senators in Congress.

1       *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*  
2       *of the United States of America in Congress assembled (two-*  
3       *thirds of each House concurring therein), That the follow-*  
4       ing article is proposed as an amendment to the Constitu-  
5       tion of the United States, which shall be valid to all intents  
6       and purposes as part of the Constitution when ratified by  
7       the legislatures of three-fourths of the several States with-  
8       in seven years after the date of its submission for ratifica-  
9       tion:

1 “ARTICLE —  
2 “No person may serve more than four consecutive  
3 terms as Representative or two consecutive terms as Sen-  
4 ator, not counting any term that began before the adop-  
5 tion of this article of amendment.”.
