## **JOINT RESOLUTION**

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States to limit the terms of office for Representatives and Senators in Congress.

- 1 Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives
- 2 of the United States of America in Congress assembled (two-
- 3 thirds of each House concurring therein), That the follow-
- 4 ing article is proposed as an amendment to the Constitu-
- 5 tion of the United States, which shall be valid to all intents
- 6 and purposes as part of the Constitution when ratified by
- 7 the legislatures of three-fourths of the several States with-
- 8 in seven years after the date of its submission for ratifica-
- 9 tion:

1 "ARTICLE —

- 2 "No person may serve more than four consecutive
- 3 terms as Representative or two consecutive terms as Sen-
- 4 ator, not counting any term that began before the adop-

5 tion of this article of amendment.".
