## **JOINT RESOLUTION**

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States establishing English as the official language of the United States.

- 1 Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives
- 2 of the United States of America in Congress assembled
- 3 (two-thirds of each House concurring therein), That the fol-
- 4 lowing article is proposed as an amendment to the Con-
- 5 stitution of the United States, which shall be valid to all
- 6 intents and purposes as part of the Constitution when
- 7 ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several
- 8 States within seven years after the date of its submission
- 9 for ratification:

1	"ARTICLE —
2	"Section 1. The English language shall be the offi
3	cial language of the United States. As the official lan
4	guage, the English language shall be used for all public
5	acts including every order, resolution, vote or election, and
6	for all records and judicial proceedings of the Government
7	of the United States and the governments of the severa
8	States.
9	"Section 2. The Congress and the States shall en
10	force this article by appropriate legislation.".
