JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States.

- 1 Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives
- 2 of the United States of America in Congress assembled
- 3 (two-thirds of each House concurring therein), That the fol-
- 4 lowing article is proposed as an amendment to the Con-
- 5 stitution of the United States, which shall be valid to all
- 6 intents and purposes as part of the Constitution when
- 7 ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several
- 8 States:
- 9 "Article—
- "Section 1. No person shall serve in the office of
- 11 United States Representative for more than three terms,

- 1 but upon ratification of this amendment no person who
- 2 has held the office of United States Representative or who
- 3 then holds the office shall serve for more than two addi-
- 4 tional terms.
- 5 "Section 2. No person shall serve in the office of
- 6 United States Senator for more than two terms, but upon
- 7 ratification of this amendment no person who has held the
- 8 office of United States Senator or who holds the office
- 9 shall serve more than one additional term.
- 10 "Section 3. This article shall have no time limit
- 11 within which it must be ratified to become operative upon
- 12 the ratification of the legislatures of three-fourths of the
- 13 several States.".
