JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States limiting the terms of offices of Members of Congress and increasing the term of Representatives to four years.

- 1 Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives
- 2 of the United States of America in Congress assembled
- 3 (two-thirds of each House concurring therein), That the fol-
- 4 lowing article is proposed as an amendment to the Con-
- 5 stitution of the United States, which shall be valid to all
- 6 intents and purposes as part of the Constitution when
- 7 ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several

- 1 States within seven years after the date of its submission
- 2 for ratification:
- 3 "Article—
- 4 "Section 1. The term of office of Representatives
- 5 shall be four years.
- 6 "No person shall be elected to the office of Represent-
- 7 ative more than three times, excluding any election of a
- 8 person to fill a vacancy of an office of a Representative
- 9 if such person has held such office for less than two years.
- 10 "The second clause of this section shall not apply to
- 11 any person who is a Representative on the date of ratifica-
- 12 tion of this Article so long as such person continues there-
- 13 after to be a Representative without an interruption in
- 14 service.
- 15 "Section 2. No person shall be elected to the office
- 16 of Senator more than twice, excluding any election of a
- 17 person to fill a vacancy of an office of a Senator if such
- 18 person has held such office for less than three years.
- 19 "This section shall not apply to any person who is
- 20 a Senator on the date of ratification of this Article so long
- 21 as such person continues thereafter to be a Senator with-
- 22 out an interruption in service.".
