JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives
- 2 of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 (two-thirds of each House concurring therein), That the fol-
- 4 lowing article is proposed as an amendment to the Con-
- 5 stitution of the United States, which shall be valid to all
- 6 intents and purposes as part of the Constitution when
- 7 ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several

- 1 States within seven years after the date of its submission
- 2 for ratification:
- 3 "ARTICLE—
- 4 "Section 1. The States shall have power to prohibit
- 5 the physical destruction of the flag of the United States
- 6 and Congress shall have the power to prohibit destruction
- 7 of federally owned flags.".
