JOINT RESOLUTION

Waiving certain enrollment requirements with respect to two
specified bills of the One Hundred Fifth Congress.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the provisions of sections 106 and 107 of title 1,
4 United States Code, are waived with respect to the print-
5 ing (on parchment or otherwise) of the enrollment of H.R.
6 2014 and of H.R. 2015 of the One Hundred Fifth Con-
7 gress. The enrollment of each of those bills shall be in
8 such form as the Committee on House Oversight of the
9 House of Representatives certifies to be a true enrollment.
