A BILL

7	(a) In General.—Section 1861 of the Social Secu-

- 6 fied individual' means an individual who is (in accordance
- 7 with regulations prescribed by the Secretary)—
- 8 "(A) an estrogen-deficient woman at clinical
- 9 risk for osteoporosis;
- 10 "(B) an individual with vertebral abnormalities;
- 11 "(C) an individual receiving long-term
- 12 glucocorticoid steroid therapy;
- 13 "(D) an individual with primary
- 14 hyperparathyroidism; or
- 15 "(E) an individual being monitored to assess
- the response to or efficacy of an approved
- osteoporosis drug therapy.".
- 18 (b) Conforming Amendments.—Sections 1864(a),
- 19 1902(a)(9)(C), and 1915(a)(1)(B)(ii)(I) of the Social Se-
- 20 curity Act (42 U.S.C. 1395aa(a), 1396a(a)(9)(C), and
- 21 1396n(a)(1)(B)(ii)(I)) are amended by striking "para-
- 22 graphs (15) and (16)" each place it appears and inserting
