A BILL

To amend title II of the Social Security Act to provide that changes to the Consumer Price Index used in making increases in social security benefits shall be restricted to changes specifically authorized by law.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Cost of Living Ac-
5 countability Act of 1997”.



1 **SEC. 2. CHANGES TO CONSUMER PRICE INDEX USED IN**
2 **MAKING ADJUSTMENTS TO SOCIAL SECURITY**
3 **BENEFITS RESTRICTED TO CHANGES SPE-**
4 **CIFICALLY AUTHORIZED BY LAW.**

5 Section 215(i)(1) of the Social Security Act (42
6 U.S.C. 415(i)(1)) is amended—

7 (1) in subparagraph (G), by striking “quarter.”
8 and inserting “quarter; and”; and

9 (2) by adding at the end the following new sub-
10 paragraph:

11 “(H) on and after the date of the enactment of
12 the Cost of Living Accountability Act of 1997, the
13 Consumer Price Index referred to in the preceding
14 provisions of this paragraph shall be prepared under
15 rules governing the market basket and other ele-
16 ments relevant in preparing such Index which are
17 identical to those which were applicable in preparing
18 such Index in connection with increases under this
19 subsection last determined before such date, except
20 to the extent otherwise provided by law enacted after
21 such date and referring to this subparagraph.”.
