- 3 SECTION 1. ALCOHOL-IMPAIRED DRIVING COUNTER MEAS-
- 4 URES.
- 5 Section 410(d) of title 23, United States Code, is
- 6 amended by adding at the end the following:

"(8) Establishment of a vehicle forfeiture system for persons operating a motor vehicle with a license which has been suspended or revoked as a result of operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcohol.".
