A BILL

To require the continued availability of \$1 Federal reserve notes for circulation.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Save the Greenback
- 5 Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. REQUIREMENT TO MAINTAIN MINIMUM AMOUNTS
- 7 OF \$1 FEDERAL RESERVE NOTES IN CIRCULA-
- 8 TION.
- 9 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Sec-
- 10 retary of the Treasury and the Board of Governors of the

- 1 Federal Reserve System shall take such action as may be
- 2 necessary to ensure that the number of Federal reserve
- 3 notes in the denomination of \$1 which are in circulation
- 4 at any time does not decrease below the number of such
- 5 reserve notes in circulation as of the date of the enactment

6 of this Act.
