 - 3 SECTION 1. SAN TIMOTEO CREEK, CALIFORNIA.
 - 4 The project for flood control, San Timoteo Creek
 - 5 (Santa Ana River Mainstem), California, authorized by
 - 6 section 401(a) of the Water Resources Development Act
 - 7 of 1986 (100 Stat. 4113), is modified to direct the Sec-
 - 8 retary of the Army to permit the non-Federal contribution

- 1 for costs of the project described in subparagraphs (B)
- 2 and (C) of section 103(a)(1) of such Act (33 U.S.C.
- 3 2213(a)(1)) to be made under section 103(k) of such Act
- 4 (33 U.S.C. 2213(k)) with interest over a period to be de-
- 5 termined by the non-Federal sponsor but not to exceed
- 6 30 years from the date of completion of the project.
