A BILL

To provide that if an employer provides additional leave to a parent for the birth such employer shall provide the same leave to a parent for an adopted child or a foster child.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LEAVE FOR ADOPTED AND FOSTER CHILDREN.**

4 If an employer provides to an employee who is a par-
5 ent leave, in addition to the leave required by the Family
6 and Medical Leave Act of 1993, for the birth of a child,

1 such employer shall provide the same leave to an employee
2 who is a parent for an adopted child or a foster child.
3 For purposes of enforcement such additional leave shall
4 be considered leave required to be provided under section
5 102 of such Act.
