- 3 SECTION 1. LEAVE FOR ADOPTED AND FOSTER CHILDREN.
- 4 If an employer provides to an employee who is a par-
- 5 ent leave, in addition to the leave required by the Family
- 6 and Medical Leave Act of 1993, for the birth of a child,

- 1 such employer shall provide the same leave to an employee
- 2 who is a parent for an adopted child or a foster child.
- 3 For purposes of enforcement such additional leave shall
- 4 be considered leave required to be provided under section

5 102 of such Act.
