AN ACT

To amend the Antiquities Act regarding the establishment by the President of certain national monuments.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 2 This Act may be cited as the "National Monument
- 3 Fairness Act of 1997".
- 4 SEC. 2. CONGRESSIONAL REVIEW OF NATIONAL MONU-
- 5 MENT STATUS AND CONSULTATION.
- 6 Section 2 of the Act of June 8, 1906, commonly re-
- 7 ferred to as the "Antiquities Act" (34 Stat. 225; 16
- 8 U.S.C. 431) is amended by adding the following at the
- 9 end thereof: "A proclamation of the President under this
- 10 section that results in the designation of a total acreage
- 11 in excess of 50,000 acres in a single State in a single cal-
- 12 endar year as a national monument may not be issued
- 13 until 30 days after the President has transmitted the pro-
- 14 posed proclamation to the Governor of the State in which
- 15 such acreage is located and solicited such Governor's writ-
- 16 ten comments, and any such proclamation shall cease to
- 17 be effective on the date 2 years after issuance unless the
- 18 Congress has approved such proclamation by joint resolu-
- 19 tion.".
