A BILL

To amend the Communications Act of 1934 to prevent splitting of local communities into multiple telephone area codes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SPLITTING OF MUNICIPALITIES PROHIBITED.**

4 Section 251(e) of the Communications Act of 1934
5 (47 U.S.C. 251(e)) is amended by adding at the end the
6 following new paragraph:

7 “(3) SPLITTING OF MUNICIPALITIES PROHIB-

8 ITED.—The Commission shall not, after the date of

9 enactment of this paragraph, permit the implemen-

10 tation of any numbering plan if such numbering

1 plan will divide any municipality with a population
2 of less than 500,000 individuals (as determined in
3 the most recent decennial census) among two or
4 more telephone number area codes.”.
