- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. CHANGE IN NATURALIZATION REQUIREMENTS
- 4 FOR CERTAIN OLDER INDIVIDUALS.
- 5 (a) In General.—Section 312(b) of the Immigra-
- 6 tion and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1423(b)) is amended—

1	(1) in paragraph (2), by striking "334," and all
2	that follows through the period at the end and in-
3	serting "334, is over sixty-five years of age and has
4	been living in the United States for periods totaling
5	at least five years subsequent to a lawful admission
6	for permanent residence."; and

- 7 (2) in paragraph (3), by striking "and has been 8 living" and all that follows through "residence." and 9 inserting a period.
- 10 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
 11 subsection (a) shall take effect on the date of the enact12 ment of this Act and shall apply to applications for natu13 ralization filed on or after such date.
