- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. RECORD OF PLACE OF BIRTH AS JERUSALEM,
- 4 ISRAEL.
- 5 For purposes of the registration of birth, certification
- 6 of nationality, or issuance of a passport of a United States
- 7 citizen born in the city of Jerusalem, the Secretary of
- 8 State shall record the place of birth as Jerusalem, Israel.
