Mr. Romero-Barceló introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on National Security, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned

A BILL

To provide for the transfer to the University of Puerto Rico of title to Federal real property and improvements used to operate a center for research on primates, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 That notwithstanding any other provision of law transfers
- 4 of real property and improvements shall be made in ac-
- 5 cordance with the following:
- 6 (1) The Secretary of Health and Human Serv-
- 7 ices, in consultation with the Director of the Na-

1 tional Institutes of Health, shall on behalf of the 2 United States transfer to the University of Puerto 3 Rico, without consideration, title to the Federal real property and improvements that as of the date of 5 the enactment of this Act constitute a center for re-6 search on primates that is located in the vicinity of 7 Sabana Seca, in the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico. 8 Such real property is a parcel consisting of approxi-9 mately 270 acres.

(2) The Secretary of the Navy, in consultation with the Director of the National Institutes of Health, shall on behalf of the United States transfer to the University of Puerto Rico, without consideration, title to the Federal real property and improvements that as of the date of the enactment of this Act are under permit from the Department of the Navy to the National Institutes of Health and that are located in close proximity to the center referred to in paragraph (1). Such real property is a parcel consisting of approximately 5.65 acres.

21 The exact acreage and legal description used for purposes 22 of a transfer under paragraph (1) or (2) shall be in ac-

23 cordance with a survey satisfactory to such Secretary.
