Mr. HAYWORTH introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of Commander Carl D. Swanson.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. COMPENSATION FOR ACCOUNTING ERROR.**

4 (a) AUTHORIZATION OF PAYMENT.—The Secretary
5 of the Treasury shall pay, out of money in the Treasury
6 not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$2,464.22 to Com-
7 mander Carl D. Swanson as compensation for an uncor-
8 rected accounting and wage payment error acknowledged
9 by the Coast Guard to have occurred between October 13,
10 1972, and January 31, 1986, while Commander Carl D.
11 Swanson was employed by the Coast Guard.

1 (b) SETTLEMENT OF CLAIMS.—The payment made
2 under subsection (a) shall be a full settlement of all claims
3 by Commander Carl D. Swanson against the United
4 States for the injuries referred to in subsection (a).

5 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON AGENTS AND ATTORNEYS' FEES.**

6 It shall be unlawful for an amount that exceeds 10
7 percent of the amount authorized by section 1 to be paid
8 to or received by any agent or attorney in consideration
9 of services rendered in connection with this Act. Any per-
10 son who violates this section shall be guilty of an infrac-
11 tion and shall be subject to a fine in the amount provided
12 in title 18, United States Code.
