To amend the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 to prohibit contributions by nonparty multicandidate political committees.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PROHIBITION OF CONTRIBUTIONS BY
- 4 NONPARTY MULTICANDIDATE POLITICAL
- 5 COMMITTEES IN ELECTIONS FOR FEDERAL
- 6 OFFICE.
- 7 Section 315 of the Federal Election Campaign Act
- 8 of 1971 (2 U.S.C. 441a) is amended by adding at the end
- 9 the following new subsection:

- 1 "(i)(1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this
- 2 Act, no nonparty multicandidate political committee may
- 3 make any contribution to a candidate for Federal office.
- 4 "(2) As used in this subsection, the term 'multican-
- 5 didate political committee' has the meaning given that
