A BILL

To authorize the Government of India to establish a memorial to honor Mahatma Gandhi in the District of Columbia.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORITY TO ESTABLISH MEMORIAL.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Government of India is au-
5 thorized to establish a memorial to honor Mahatma Gan-
6 dhi on the Federal land in the District of Columbia de-
7 scribed in subsection (b).

8 (b) LOCATION OF MEMORIAL.—The Federal land re-
9 ferred to in subsection (a) is the triangle of land in the
10 District of Columbia that is bordered by 21st Street, NW.,

1 Q Street, NW., and Massachusetts Avenue, NW., and des-
2 ignated as plot number 58 in Area II on the map num-
3 bered 869/86501 and dated May 1, 1986, which is located
4 across Massachusetts Avenue, NW., from the Embassy of
5 India.

6 (c) COMPLIANCE WITH STANDARDS FOR COMMEMO-
7 RATIVE WORKS.—The establishment of the memorial shall
8 be in accordance with the Commemorative Works Act (40
9 U.S.C. 1001 et seq.).

10 (d) LIMITATION ON PAYMENT OF EXPENSES.—The
11 Government of the United States shall not pay any ex-
12 pense of the establishment of the memorial.
