A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to apply standards to outpatient physical therapy provided as an incident to a physician's professional services.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Outpatient Physical
- 5 Therapy Standards Act of 1997".

1	SEC. 2. APPLICATION OF STANDARDS TO OUTPATIENT OC-
2	CUPATIONAL AND PHYSICAL THERAPY SERV-
3	ICES PROVIDED AS AN INCIDENT TO A PHYSI-
4	CIAN'S PROFESSIONAL SERVICES.
5	(a) In General.—Section 1862(a) of the Social Se-
6	curity Act (42 U.S.C. 1395y(a)) is amended—
7	(1) by striking "or" at the end of paragraph
8	(14);
9	(2) by striking the period at the end of para-
10	graph (15) and inserting "; or"; and
11	(3) by inserting after paragraph (15) the fol-
12	lowing:
13	"(16) in the case of outpatient occupational
14	therapy services or outpatient physical therapy serv-
15	ices furnished as an incident to a physician's profes-
16	sional services (as described in section
17	1861(s)(2)(A)), that do not meet the standards and
18	conditions under section 1861(g) or 1861(p) as such
19	standards and conditions would apply to such ther-
20	apy services if furnished by a therapist subject to
21	section 1861(g) or 1861(p).".
22	(b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
23	this section apply to services furnished on or after Janu-
24	ary 1, 1998.
